Car parking space at the front of the school is limited; if you live locally and can walk it would help.

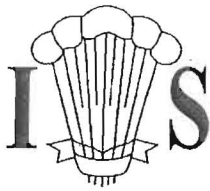
I will address parents at 18:30 and again at 19:30 in the assembly hall.
