Surrey Police is reminding young people to be vigilant following a suspicious incident in Oxted.

The incident happened around 3.30pm on Tuesday, 17 May on Water Lane when an upset 15-year-old girl was waiting after school to be collected.

A car approached the student from Limpsfield Grange School and a man, the sole occupant of the vehicle asked from the window if she was ok and if he could do anything to help, the male offered the use of a phone and said it was at his house.

The girl declined and the man said he would go and fetch a phone for her to use. He then left the area. At no point did the man make physical contact with the girl nor did he try and force her into the vehicle.

Male described as an old looking man possibly in his 60's, with grey hair and glasses in a car described as being long like an estate.

At this stage we are not sure whether the man was just trying to help a young girl who was visibly upset.

“Anyone, not just young people should always remain vigilant when in public places and should never get into a vehicle or enter a property with a person they do not know or trust”.

Neighbourhood officers are putting on extra patrols in the area around school times and would like anyone with concerns to approach them.
